Ask:

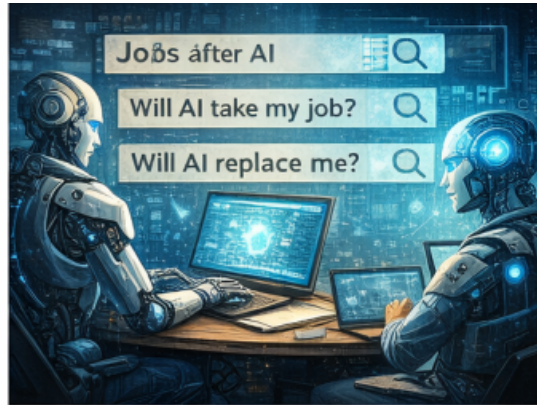
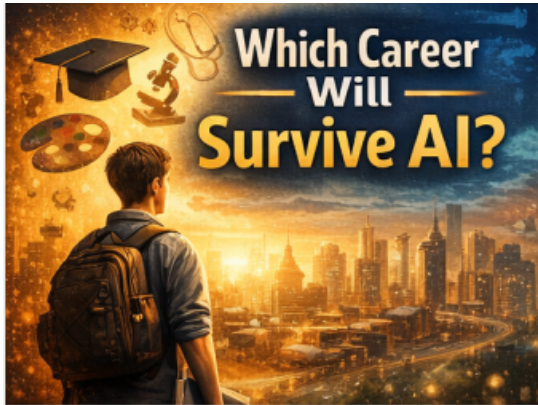
□ What will grow tomorrow?
